Health: excellent! He has received all his puppy shots and more, and survived parvo as a pup when half his sibs died. Heartworm tested and on heartworm meds. Personality: big, friendly and curious! He has never been aggressive with people or other dogs, and he wants to be involved in whatever you are doing. He is rambunctious and has a lot on energy, and is still in the "mouthy" puppy phase and so will possibly chew on select items. The Malinois breed has a high prey drive and Archie like to chase. He is an excellent watchdog and will bark when strangers approach the house.



Kids: he was born in a house with small children and

has been around them a lot. However his big size and desire to be "involved" and in the middle of things means he's kind of difficult with kids playing on the floor. He also tries to sit in your lap- too much for a smaller kid. We would put him in his crate or outside when the grandkids came over (after saying hi). But no issues with aggression at all! Training: crate trained; knows basic sit, come, stay, leave it. He's is smart and learns quickly and is VERY treat motivated. Walks on a leash but needs work as he wants to pull and is very strong.

Other animals: his birth home had 3 cats but since then he has only been around feral cats, which unfortunately run from him and he will chase. I don't think he'd hurt them but I wouldn't immediately trust him without supervision.

Smaller dogs: he lives with a chihuahua who constantly snarks at him, and he is not aggressive back. He does tend to "nose" the chihuahua which causes the snark. Food aggression: I have only seen him aggressively bark at the chihuahua when the chihuahua tries to sneak in and grab crumbs from Archie's treat as he bites it and crumbs fall.

He has NO history of aggression towards people or other animals. He would need to be trained/watched though with any animals that run (cats, chickens, etc) as that is kind of an unknown
